

## Ordinance 30 Student Disciplinary Procedure

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## ORDINANCE 30 STUDENT DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURE

- 1. The Senate shall by Regulation determine the procedure to be followed in student disciplinary cases.
- 2. Such a procedure shall include:
  - 1. the right of the student to be told of the charges against him/her and the possible penalties;
  - 2. the right of the student to make written and oral representation to the person or committee established under such Regulation to deal with the case;
  - 3. the right of the student to be accompanied if he/she chooses by another person, who may speak on his/her behalf;
  - 4. the right of the student to call and question witnesses;
  - 5. details of the penalties which may be imposed by the University if the student is found to have been guilty of a breach of discipline;
  - 6. the right for the student to appeal against the decision and any disciplinary penalty imposed.
