## CRIMINOLOGY

Answer THREE questions

- 1. Discuss whether the prison system in England and Wales could be described as being in an ongoing state of crisis.
- 2. Why are black and minority ethnic groups disproportionately over-represented in police stop and search statistics in England and Wales? In your answer, consider ways in which you think the problems arising from this disproportionality could be addressed.
- 3. Describe and explain how popular media portrayals of crime and criminal justice might influence public perceptions and understandings of crime.
- 4. Discuss how useful official crime statistics are in providing an accurate picture of the types and amount of crime occurring in society.
- 5. Consider the benefits and limitations of using restorative justice and mediation in resolving the harms arising from criminal offences.
- 6. Described by Hirschi and Gottfredson (1983: 552) as a 'brute fact of criminology', nearly all criminal and offending behaviour peaks in late adolescence and declines thereafter. How can this phenomenon be explained?
- 7. With reference to the relationship between gender, crime and criminal justice, consider why the majority of recorded crime is committed by males and not females.
